SUBJECT: Approve Resolution Authorizing a March 8, 2011 Special Election for the Tahoe Truckee Unified School District and Authorizing the County Registrar of Voters to Render Reimbursed Election Services for the Election

Recommendation

Approve the attached resolution calling a March 8, 2011 Special Election as requested by the Tahoe Truckee Unified School District and authorizing the County Registrar of Voters to render reimbursed election services for the District.

Background

Elections Code Section 10002 and Education Code Section 5303 provide that the governing body of any school district may by resolution request the Board of Supervisors to conduct their elections and permit the County Registrar of Voters to render necessary election services to the district on a reimbursable basis.

The Tahoe Truckee Unified School District on October 20, 2010, adopted a resolution by their governing board, requesting the Placer County Registrar of Voters to conduct a March 8, 2011 Special Election for extension of the District's existing parcel tax.

In order for the County Registrar of Voters to perform the special election functions requested by the Tahoe Truckee Unified School District pursuant to Elections Code Section 10002, the Elections Office must have the approval of your Board.

Fiscal Impact

The Tahoe Unified School District will pay for the actual costs of their requested special election as provided for in Elections Code Section 10002 and in the approved fee schedule for election services set forth in Placer County Code Section 2.116.140.A.

WHEREAS, the Tahoe Truckee Unified School District has ordered a Special Election to be held in its jurisdiction on March 8, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the wording for said measure has been delivered to the County Clerk and is presented to the Placer County Board of Supervisors as Exhibit A (see attached); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 10002 of the Elections Code and Section 5303 of the Education Code, the Governing Body of a School District may request the Board of Supervisors to call elections and permit the County Clerk-Recorder-Registrar of Voters to render specified services to said Body relating to the conduct of elections on a reimbursable basis; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Placer County Board of Supervisors that the Tahoe Truckee Unified School District Special Election shall be held on March 8, 2011; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Placer hereby authorizes the Placer County Registrar of Voters to render any and all necessary special election services to the Tahoe Truckee Unified School District for the March 8, 2011 election and to be reimbursed for such services by the District.

EXHIBIT A

Measure A – Tahoe Truckee Unified School District

To reduce the impact of budget cuts and ensure all students receive a high quality education by preventing reductions in science, music, art, technology, physical education, college preparation, honors/advanced placement classes and vocational education, retaining librarians, counselors and nurses, and maintaining funding for school equipment and supplies, shall Tahoe Truckee Unified School District renew its expiring parcel tax for 7 years, at 135 dollars per year, with senior exemptions, citizens oversight, and annual audits?
