Kathy won her first election as a Councilmember in November 1985. She served as Councilmember for six consecutive terms. She has contributed to the success of many programs over the years which led to Rocklin being honored by Family Circle Magazine as one of the 10 top cities in America to raise a family; being recognized by Money Magazine as one of the top 100 small cities, population under 100,000, in America; and being acclaimed by Sacramento Magazine as the best city in the region to raise a family.

- Implementing an emergency fund for the City
- Developing joint facilities with the Rocklin Unified School District

- Construction of the "Safe Routes to School" improvements throughout old town Rocklin; and
- Developing the city's General Plan; and
- Developing a city-wide park system that consists of 30 parks that provide recreation and fitness opportunities within ½-mile or less of every residence citywide; and
- Transforming the Placer County Transportation Board to the, "Placer County Transportation Agency" which encompasses all six cities and the county. This agency created a cooperative network between city agencies that has successfully secured state transportation for the county and cities in Placer County; and

Whereas Kathy is most proud of the fact that Rocklin has been known, for the last 25 years, to have a stable government; and
