BACKGROUND/COMMUNITY BENEFITS: In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants therefore a benefit results to the County.

The Board of Supervisors is being asked to approve appropriations to help support *KidsFirst* Incredible Years (Parent and Child) Training Classes Program. This program helps parents gain tools to deal with behavioral problems in young children and instructs them how to continue to handle difficult behavior as the child goes through various developmental stages. *KidsFirst* works collaboratively with Placer County Child System of Care and is designated to approach families to make assessments of reported situations involving children. Since its inception in 1989, *KidsFirst* has provided child abuse prevention services to more than fifty thousand children.
