BACKGROUND/COMMUNITY BENEFITS

Dennis began his career with the County nearly 24 years ago as a Deputy Sheriff. He spent a majority of his career assigned as a resident deputy to the Foresthill Substation. He served as a Search & Rescue Coordinator and Mountain Rescue Team Leader where he was instrumental in the team earning re-certification and national recognition as one of the best in California. His high level of competency and expertise served him well in the areas he worked within the Department, including Corrections, Field Operations, Transportation Unit and when assigned to specialized teams, such as Dive Team and the K-9 Unit.

Dennis has been a dedicated and loyal public servant and is well respected by his co-workers and outside agencies with whom he works.
