SUBJECT: RESOLUTION - Approve a Resolution commending Placer County Chief Probation Officer, Stephen G. Pecor for 29 years of dedicated service to Placer County.

ACTION REQUESTED

Present a Resolution commending Placer County Chief Probation Officer, Stephen G. Pecor for 29 years of dedicated public service to Placer County.

BACKGROUND/COMMUNITY BENEFITS

Chief Probation Officer Pecor was hired by Placer County on August 12, 1982 as an Extra Help Group Counselor and became a permanent Placer County employee on August 6, 1983, as a Group Counselor I. During his career he has worked in various divisions and management positions until his promotion to Chief Probation Officer on July 8, 2006. As Chief Probation Officer Steve has earned the highest respect of the Bench, the local Bar, local law enforcement agencies, and the Probation Officers and staff who have served with him and under his leadership.

In December 2010, Steve brought state wide recognition to the Placer County Probation Department, when he was recognized by the Chief Probation Officers of California as the Chief Probation Officer of the Year for 2010.

The Board of Supervisors will be presenting Stephen G. Pecor with a resolution in honor of his service to Placer County. He will retire from Placer County on April 23, 2011.
