SUBJECT: Agreement between the County of Placer and California Rice Commission

ACTION REQUESTED

Adopt a resolution authorizing the Agricultural Commissioner/Sealer to sign an agreement with the California Rice Commission allowing reimbursement from the California Rice Commission for up to \$1000 for costs associated with increased surveillance to enforce restricted material permit conditions.

BACKGROUND

The County Agricultural Commissioner/Sealer is responsible for enforcing all laws and regulations related to pesticide use in Placer County. Under this agreement, the County will be reimbursed up to a maximum of \$1,000 for costs associated with increased surveillance to enforce restricted material pesticide permit conditions.

ENVIRONMENTAL

This activity does not qualify as a project under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).

FISCAL IMPACT

This revenue reimbursement is for an ongoing program and has no impact on the General Fund.
