The Board of Supervisors is being asked to approve appropriations to help support the Fruitvale Summer Camp program held June 27th – August 5th at Fruitvale School in Lincoln.

The Fruitvale School Summer Camp program is designed to encourage outdoor activities with creative learning opportunities. The program is held in the foothills of Lincoln at Fruitvale School. Their daily activities include outdoor age appropriate guided play for boys and girls that encourages running, climbing trees, riding bikes and imaginary play. They also include farm animal classes where the children work with the animals to learn proper care, feeding and grooming for all types of farm animals, activity classes that include crafts, cooking and art and finally a study hour to provide specialized tutoring for students having difficulty in various academic subjects.
