BACKGROUND/COMMUNITY BENEFITS: In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants therefore a benefit results to the County.

The Board of Supervisors is being asked to approve appropriations to help cover the shortfall of \$1,388 needed to fully fund the 2010-2011 Miles of Smiles dental program offered to elementary school children in Roseville.

The, “Miles of Smiles” dental program is an annual program to apply dental sealants to molars for elementary school children in Roseville. The program has served hundreds of children and has given them the opportunity to have improved dental health.

The unfunded portion of the costs to cover the program during 2010-2011 occurred due to the budget cuts and the county Health Department not being able to fund their share of the program. The program final costs were \$13,888, with total revenue of \$12,500; leaving a short fall of \$1,388.
