SUBJECT: **FY 2009/2010 PROPOSITION 1B TRANSIT FUNDS**

ACTION REQUESTED / RECOMMENDATION

Adopt a Resolution authorizing the Director of Public Works to complete the necessary applications to receive \$7,500 in unspent FY 2009/2010 Transit System Safety, Security and Disaster Response Account (TSSSDRA) Proposition 1B Transit funds allocated by PCTPA for Onboard Surveillance Camera System for both PCT and TART.

BACKGROUND / SUMMARY

Proposition 1B is a \$19.9 billion Bond Measure for various transportation programs which was approved by voters in November of 2006. This subprogram under the Bond Measure provides funds for local transit projects. The Transit System Safety, Security, and Disaster Response Account (TSSSDRA) provide funds for public transit safety and security projects. This program will provide funding through 2017.

Placer County Transportation Planning Agency (PCTPA) has allocated an additional \$7,500 in unspent FY 2009/10 TSSSDRA funds to Placer County. DPW is proposing to add these funds to the 'Onboard Surveillance Camera System' project approved by the Board of Supervisors in March of 2010, in the amount of \$170,174. The purpose of this project is to install surveillance cameras on the bus fleets for both Placer County Transit (PCT) and Tahoe Area Regional Transit (TART). These systems are now common among bus operators and are used primarily for accident and claim investigations, as well as investigation of vandalism and other passenger related incidents.

ENVIRONMENTAL

The project is statutorily exempt from CEQA pursuant to Section 21080(b)(10), as it is a project to provide passenger service.

FISCAL IMPACT

If the projects are approved at the State, the funds will flow after bonds are sold. Purchase commitments will not be made until the funds are received by Placer County. This revenue and the associated expenditure will be included in the Final 2011/12 Budget.
