

Subject: Remote Access Network (RAN) Board Appointee

Action Requested

Re-appoint Supervisor Holmes to serve on the Remote Access Network (RAN) Board in accordance with Article 3.5 of the California Penal Code, section 11112.4 (b).

Background

In March of 2007 your Board adopted Resolution 2007-80 for the collection of vehicle registration fees to fund the Remote Access Network within the County. The monies estimated at \$300,000 annually is collected and deposited into the Automated Fixed and Mobile Identification Fund and used exclusively to fund programs that enhance the capacity of local law enforcement agencies to provide automated mobile and fixed location photo and fingerprint identification of individuals who may be involved in crimes. The local RAN Board is comprised of seven members by legislation. The members designated are the Sheriff, two City Law Enforcement Officials, a member of the Board of Supervisors, the District Attorney, a City Mayor and a member at large. The RAN Board makes decisions on how funds are spent. The uses of funds are quite specific such as latent finger and palm identification; photo identification; related equipment and infrastructure; staff support and telecommunications services between law enforcement agencies.

Fiscal Impact

There is no fiscal impact.
