SUBJECT: **REVENUE SHARING** – Approve the appropriation of \$750 in Revenue Sharing monies to the Placer County Law Enforcement Chaplaincy to help fund the ***Annual Volunteer Firefighter Appreciation Dinner***, as requested by Supervisor Weygandt (\$250) and Supervisor Holmes (\$500).

ACTION REQUESTED

Approve the appropriation of \$750 in Revenue Sharing monies to the Placer County Law Enforcement Chaplaincy to help fund the ***Annual Volunteer Firefighter Appreciation Dinner***, as requested by Supervisor Weygandt (\$250) and Supervisor Holmes (\$500).

BACKGROUND/COMMUNITY BENEFITS

In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants therefore a benefit results to the County.

The Board of Supervisors is being asked to approve appropriations to help fund the ***Annual Volunteer Firefighter Appreciation Dinner*** on April 19th. Placer County Law Enforcement Chaplaincy (PCLEC) responds to incidents alongside all types of first responders, including volunteer firefighters. To help support these volunteer firefighters, PCLEC is co-sponsoring the appreciation dinner along with Placer County Fire. The fire departments deliver services by using both career professional and citizen volunteer firefighters. Although volunteer firefighters do not get compensated, they are often required to obtain the same amount of training as their paid counterparts so as to be prepared to respond to a number of incidents including , but not limited to emergency medical, hazardous material, technical rescues, natural disasters, terrorists acts, wild land fires, structure fires, and vehicle collisions. Roughly forty-five volunteer firefighters will be honored from the areas of Dutch Flat, Lonestar, Fowler, Thermalands, Sheridan, Paige, and Dry Creek. In addition to the firefighters of Placer County, equally dedicated volunteers from Colfax City Volunteer Fire Department and Alta Fire Protection District will be honored at the dinner. The four awards being presented to each volunteer company this year are: Firefighter of the Year; Most Improved, Most Trainings Attended, and Rookie of the Year. Funds received will be used to purchase award plaques and help pay for the cost of catering this event.
