**BACKGROUND/COMMUNITY BENEFITS**

In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants, therefore a benefit results to the County.

The Board of Supervisors is being asked to approve appropriations to help fund the Art League of Lincoln. The Art League was formed in March of 2012, after the previous Art Association closed leaving no supplies, equipment or funding for a new organization. The purpose of the Art League of Lincoln is to celebrate, promote and teach the history and future of art in Lincoln to its community and surrounding areas through exhibits, presentations, gallery shows and art classes for all ages. A National Ceramic Art Show has been scheduled for April 20, 2013, however, the Art League is still in need of many things before they are able to host this event. Designated funding will be used to purchase display materials, pedestals, easels, computer and printer equipment, chairs, and other office supplies.

The Art League of Lincoln celebrates, promotes and teaches the history and future of art in Lincoln to it's community and surrounding areas.


