BACKGROUND/COMMUNITY BENEFITS

In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants therefore a benefit results to the County.

The Board of Supervisors is being asked to approve appropriations to help fund the Placer Community Foundation’s **Third Annual Nonprofit Leadership Summit** to be held on May 9, 2013. For the past seven years the Placer Community Foundation (PCF) has been making technical assistance grants to support the capacity needs of local nonprofits. In 2012, PCF awarded seventeen nonprofits Community Wellness Mini-Grants totaling \$260,000. These grants have supported community-based projects that are helping to promote overall wellness among county residents, and address the needs of underserved populations. Last year nearly 250 nonprofit board and executive staff members attended the Leadership Summit to learn how to best sustain their organization and its services, with over 50 of the community-based organizations being from Placer County. The Summit was developed to maximize the impact and serve the greatest number of local nonprofits, and well over 250 people are expected to attend this year’s Summit. Designated funding will be used to cover costs associated with providing a facility to comfortably seat and feed 250 participants for an all-day event, and marketing and outreach to the nonprofit sector.
