Subject: California State Department of Recreation, Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Grant

Action Requested

1. Adopt a Resolution authorizing the Sheriff to execute the grant award from the Off-Highway Motor Vehicle (OHV) Grant administered by the Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Recreation Division with the California Department of Parks and Recreation. The Grant amount is \$16,987 for FY 2013-14, commencing July 1, 2013 to June 30, 2014.
2. Authorize the Purchasing Manager to execute all related documents.
3. Add the equipment to the Master Fixed Asset List.

Background

The Placer County Sheriff's Office will utilize the Off-Highway Vehicle grant funding to purchase an all-terrain vehicle, trailer, safety equipment.

Based on data obtained from the U.S. Forest Service and Bureau of Land Management, Placer County provides thousands of miles of OHV approved trails and roads. The County is currently host for many ATV / Dirt Bike events and multiple activities on the Rubicon trail. The Sheriff's Office receives calls for service regarding incidents and accidents, OHV safety and private property intrusions with no feasible means to respond and effectively handle the problem. Currently we have no access to many OHV trails during summer peak period usage. With the assistance from the California OHV Program, we can educate off-roaders, effectively patrol heavy use areas and take corrective actions against willful violators.

Fiscal Impact

Funds in the amount of \$16,987 from this grant will be added to the Sheriff's Office FY 2013-14 Final Budget. There is no impact to the General Fund.
