SUBJECT: Annual Report of the Placer County Youth Commission

ACTION REQUESTED:

1. Receive the Placer County Youth Commission Annual Report for FY 2012-13 as required by Resolution 2009-116.

BACKGROUND:

On May 12, 2009, the Placer County Youth Commission (PCYC) was established by unanimous vote of Resolution 2009-116. The resolution requires that an annual report be prepared and delivered to the Board of Supervisors on or about June 1.

The FY 2012-13 Commissioners had another exciting year developing partnerships and collaborations, researching issues, executing community forums and events, and supporting community projects. Highlights included hosting a multi-day County Youth Summit, participating in many community forums, working to reduce underage drinking, funding and supporting other youth-serving partners, hosting a Community World Café on Youth Engagement, and partnering on a grant submission proposing activities to reduce mental health stigma and discrimination. Additionally, the PCYC provided leadership roles and experiences that helped Placer County youth acquire unique appointments, awards, and higher education opportunities.
