BACKGROUND

In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants therefore a benefit results to the County.

The Board of Supervisors is being asked to approve appropriations to the *Keaton Raphael Memorial* to help fund their Inaugural Gala event being held on September 20, 2013. The Keaton Raphael Memorial will be celebrating their 15 year anniversary and September is also Childhood Cancer Awareness month. Proceeds from this event will benefit the Family Navigator Hope Chest program for recently diagnosed kids. The Hope Chest program provides financial assistance to the families, who are often facing financial hardship. Also provided in the Hope Chest is a personalized handmade fleece blanket for the child, gift cards for the siblings, specific information about the child's cancer, and a journal for the child to write in. The money raised from this event will directly impact local kids who have cancer and their families.
