

He promoted through the ranks to that of Captain in 2001 and currently serves as the Auburn Field Operations Commander.

WHEREAS, David Keyes is retiring from the County of Placer, Office of the Sheriff after serving that agency and the citizens of this County for nearly 29 years; and

WHEREAS, David's desire to excel led to his graduation from the FBI National Academy in 1994 and from California Command College in 2000 and led to his promotion through the ranks to that of Captain in 2001. His dedication to the Office of the Sheriff and the citizens of the community was exemplary. Throughout his career he has performed at a high level. He is a skilled manager and outstanding budget administrator and was instrumental in the formation of the organization's five-year Strategic Plan. He currently serves as Terrorism Liaison Officer-Coordinator to the Sacramento Regional Terrorist Threat Assessment Center; and

WHEREAS, his community involvement is exemplary as the representative to the Highway 49 Business Association, serving as president in 2000, and serving on the North Auburn Municipal Advisory Council. Dave was a member of the Placer County Law Enforcement Chaplaincy Board of Directors and currently serves on the Auburn Salvation Army Advisory Board where for five years he organized and led the Sheriff's Office to victory in the Battle of the Badges Kettle Drive Competition; and

WHEREAS, David has worked in almost every area within the department, including Patrol in Auburn and the North Lake Tahoe Substation, Corrections, as Commander of the South Placer Substation, and since 2004 as Commander of the Auburn Field Operations Division. Dave is a valued member of the Sheriff's executive team and has performed with unfailing professionalism and conscientious attention to duty throughout his career.
