

We are writing to express our absolute opposition to the prior Board approval of the above mentioned minor use permit allowing a business of "sales and repairs of firearms" in our residential neighborhood. This approval is very inappropriate for the area designated. For heavens sake, we don't allow massage parlors, marijuana dispensaries or liquor stores in the middle of our residential neighborhoods so why would we allow a firearms dealer? We totally support the right to have firearms, and own them ourselves, but we do not believe this type of business should be allowed in a strictly residential area.
