Subject: Marijuana Suppression Program Grant

Action Requested

Adopt a Resolution authorizing the Sheriff to execute a grant award from the Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC) Marijuana Suppression Program (MSP) in the amount of \$179,873, to fund one Deputy Sheriff assigned to the Placer County Marijuana Suppression Unit from October 1, 2013 to September 30, 2014.

Background

The BSCC MSP grant was first awarded to the Placer County Sheriff's Marijuana Suppression Program in 2010. This year's funding is in the amount of \$179,873. The overall goal of the MSP is to suppress illegal marijuana cultivation, trafficking, sales, and use in Placer County. The Sheriff's Office believes realization of these objectives will directly result in decreased drug availability and improved public safety throughout the community.

Fiscal Impact

MSP Grant funding is included in the Sheriff's Office FY 2013-14 Budget. There is no additional fiscal impact to the General Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Sheriff is authorized on behalf of this Governing Board to execute the grant application for FY 2013-14 funding, commencing October 1, 2013 to September 30, 2014 and sign the Grant Agreement with the BSCC, including any amendments or modifications thereafter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that federal grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the implementing agency/organization and partnering entities agree to abide by the statutes and regulations governing the federal Justice Assistance

Grant Program as well as the terms and conditions of the Grant Agreement as set forth by the BSCC.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors approves the grant application between Placer County Sheriff's Office and the Board of State and Community Corrections in the maximum amount of \$179,873 and authorizes Sheriff-Coroner-Marshal, Edward N. Bonner, to execute the grant application.
