SUBJECT: FENCE REPLACEMENT CSA NO. 1-CONTRACT NO. 1179

ACTION REQUESTED / RECOMMENDATION

1. Approve the project plans and specifications for use in bidding and construction of the Fence Replacement CSA No. 1. There is no net County cost.
2. Authorize the Department to advertise for bids.

BACKGROUND / SUMMARY

The Fence Replacement CSA No. 1 is adjacent to the Dollar Point Subdivision in Tahoe City, California. The first section of fencing is from the intersection of Dollar Drive and Highway 28 West (adjacent to Highway 28), an approximate length of 180 feet. The second section of fencing is from the intersection of Dollar Drive and Highway 28 East (adjacent to Highway 28), an approximate length of 950 feet.

The proposed construction includes, but is not limited to, removing two sections of "good neighbor" fencing, approximately 1,200 linear feet and providing the materials and construction of a new fence at the same location.

ENVIRONMENTAL


This project is categorically exempt from the provisions of CEQA under the following sections: Section 15301, Existing Facilities, Class 1; Section 15302, Replacement or Reconstruction, Class 2b.

FISCAL IMPACT


The total project cost is estimated to be \$135,520 with construction costs estimated at \$104,600. The project is fully funded through CSA No. 1, funding totally dedicated for the fence. Funding for the construction of this project is included in the FY 2014-15 Budget.
