The Board of Supervisors is being asked to approve appropriations to help support the Lincoln Volunteer Center’s 13th annual *Tour de Lincoln* fundraising event, held on May 10, 2014. This event brings hundreds of cyclist from Northern California and Nevada yearly generating revenue for local hotels and eateries.
