**Action Requested**

Approve the grant application for the Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) in the amount of \$23,962 to partially offset the cost of one Deputy Sheriff assigned to the Placer County Special Investigations Unit and authorize the Sheriff to execute the grant application. The grant period is from July 1, 2014 to June 30, 2016.

**Background**

The Sheriff's Office plans to utilize the annual JAG Grant for FY 2014-15 in the amount of \$23,962 to partially offset the costs of one Deputy Sheriff assigned to the Special Investigations Unit (SIU) task force. This position works as a liaison between SIU, the Courts and other County departments and monitors high-risk situations for children in Placer County. SIU works with school resource officers in Placer County to identify individuals who are selling drugs at local schools and to help determine what drugs are being sold. SIU contributes to the safety and well-being of Placer County residents and is part of the County's fight against drugs such as methamphetamines.

**Fiscal Impact**

This grant award is for \$23,962 and will be included in the Sheriff's Office FY 2014-15 Final Budget. There is no additional fiscal impact to the General Fund.
