ACTION REQUESTED

BACKGROUND/COMMUNITY BENEFITS

In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants therefore a benefit results to the County.

The Board of Supervisors is being asked to approve appropriations for the Rocklin Community Animal Shelter, who in conjunction with the Rocklin Volunteer Police Department is sponsoring the *Mayor's Cup Golf Tournament* fundraising event on August 22, 2014, at Whitney Oaks Golf Course in Rocklin. The Rocklin Community Animal Shelter was established by Dr. Basra of the Rocklin Ranch Veterinarian Hospital in 2012 after the Rocklin City Council requested assistance in rescuing, helping and sheltering animals found in the city. The Animal Shelter provides temporary housing for lost or unwanted animals, and provides a vehicle for owners to find their pets, rescue animals, and provides adoption services for animals to go to a caring and supportive home. By March of 2013, the number of animals coming into the shelter outgrew the capacity to hold them, which necessitated moving the shelter to a new location. The new Pacific Street location in Rocklin is currently housing 55 animals and is capable of housing up to 70 animals. Although the shelter is staffed mostly by volunteers, the cost of food and veterinarian expenses remains high. Funding received will help defer the cost of supplies, tee and hole flags, banners, and the cost of using the golf course for the *Mayor's Cup Golf Tournament*. Proceeds from the tournament will be shared with the Rocklin Volunteer Police Department.
