**BACKGROUND/COMMUNITY BENEFITS**

In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants therefore a benefit results to the County.

The Board of Supervisors is being asked to approve appropriations to help fund The Salvation Army's *Feed the Hungry of Auburn* program. For the last twenty-one years, the Feed the Hungry of Auburn program has participated in the autumn ritual of purchasing 4-H livestock animals at the Gold Country Fair. The purchase of these animals at this year's fair auction on September 6, 2014, will provide one of the few sources of protein for the The Salvation Army's food closet. Last year, The Salvation Army of Auburn provided over 100,000 meals to people in the community from their food closet. The funds designated for the program will assist with purchasing and processing the livestock animals which will then be donated to The Salvation Army of Auburn's food closet.
