SUBJECT: Resolution Approving Fair Political Practices Act 2014 Biennial Reports and Amendments to Conflict of Interest Codes of Placer County Local Agencies

Action Requested

Adopt a resolution approving Fair Political Practices Act 2014 Biennial Reports and Amendments to Conflict of Interest Codes of Placer County Local Agencies.

Background

The Political Reform Act requires every local government agency to review its conflict of interest code every two (2) years to determine if it complies with current law, accurately depicts the appropriate list of designated employees and the appropriate disclosure level, and clearly indicates the agency filing officer.

The Placer County Board of Supervisors is the conflict of interest code reviewing body for local agencies, other than cities, that are located wholly within Placer County to ensure compliance with State law. Each even-numbered year, the local agencies are required to submit a report to the County indicating whether their conflict of interest code is sufficient or requires amendment. This office has provided the required notice to the agencies on behalf of your Board, and has reviewed the responses to determine whether they are legally adequate.

All agencies have responded to our notice. We have reviewed each of the responses and find the documents submitted to be in compliance with the law.

Fiscal Impact

No fiscal impact is created by either approving or denying this resolution.
