BACKGROUND/COMMUNITY BENEFITS

The Board of Supervisors is being asked to approve appropriations to the American Legion to help Christian Johnson with the construction and installation costs of the Veteran's Memorial Monument that he is constructing for his Boy Scout Eagle Community Service Project. Once completed, this uniquely sculpted monument will be installed at the Loomis Memorial Hall to remember and honor the fallen soldiers from the Loomis area that made the ultimate sacrifice while serving in the Armed Forces.
