SUBJECT: Administrative Amendment with Turning Point Community Programs.

ACTION REQUESTED:

1. Approve first amendment to contract CN013321 with Turning Point Community Programs for outpatient mental health services from July 1, 2013, through September 30, 2014.

BACKGROUND:

Turning Point Community Programs provides intensive out-patient mental health services in a sustainable and cost-effective service delivery model.

Clients are screened and triaged into intensive mental health services. Services are individualized and include mental health and substance abuse treatment, medication services, employment and housing assistance. Clients have access to case management services 24 hours per day, seven days per week. Research has shown that when clients receive these services there are reductions in jail recidivism, decrease in hospitalizations, decreased homeless days and improved quality of life and self-sufficiency. Turning Point has successfully provided these services since 2008.

This change is necessary to reconcile the actual expenditures (based on program need) to the expenditure funding source. There is no change in the total dollar amount of the contract.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Due to Federal auditing requirements, \$6,419 dollars needs to be moved from the Placer County – AB109 funding line in the July-Sept 2014 Budget column to the Placer County – MHSA funding line. There is no change to the original contract amount; an additional amount of \$6,419 Mental Health Services Act dollars will be spent, 100% State funding. No County General Funds are required.

This contract amendment is on file with the Clerk of the Board for review.
