SUBJECT: **ADDITION OF LINCOLN BUSES TO THE PLACER COUNTY TRANSIT FLEET**

ACTION REQUESTED / RECOMMENDATION

1. Approve a Resolution adding eight (8) buses from the City of Lincoln to the Master Fixed Asset List in order to take ownership of the buses for the operation of transit on behalf of the City of Lincoln. There is no charge for these buses and there is no net County cost.

BACKGROUND / SUMMARY

On February 24, 2015, your Board, along with the Lincoln City Council, approved an agreement to operate transit services in Lincoln on behalf of the City. As part of this agreement the City will transfer title and registration of their existing transit fleet into the Placer County Transit (PCT) fleet. The City currently operates seven buses for their fixed route and dial-a-ride service. In order for the County to receive ownership of the vehicles, they must be placed on the Master Fixed Asset.

Under the agreement, the County will be responsible for operating and maintaining the buses. The markings on the bus will be changed to indicate they are being operated by Placer County Transit and to show they are part of PCT. The Dial-A-Ride buses will be turned over to our contractor, MV Transportation, to operate and maintain. This will happen in May, of 2015. The fixed route buses will be turned over to PCT to operate and maintain in July of 2015.

ENVIRONMENTAL

The project is statutorily exempt from CEQA pursuant to section 21080(b)(10), as it is a project to provide passenger service.

FISCAL IMPACT

The buses will be transferred from Lincoln to Placer County at no charge to the County. Pursuant to the terms of the transit operations agreement, the County will charge Lincoln for the operation and maintenance of the vehicles, as well as any one-time startup costs related to placing the vehicles into operation. The City will reimburse Placer County the cost of replacing the buses.
