**BACKGROUND/COMMUNITY BENEFITS**

In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants therefore a benefit results to the County.

The Board of Supervisors is being asked to approve appropriations to Stand Up Placer to help support their *Stand Up and Dance* event with the Placer County Stars held on April 4, 2015. Stand Up Placer has a 36 year history of providing comprehensive services for Placer County victims of domestic violence and sexual assault and their families. Stand Up Placer operates essential programs for Placer County residents who have experienced the trauma of domestic and sexual violence, and informs the Placer community that a stand is being taken against violence. The *Stand Up and Dance* event will help raise funds that will go toward operating the emergency safe house, offering individual and family counseling, legal advocacy and access to emergency food and transportation, and job readiness workshops. Funding received will be used to help cover the costs of the event, and supplies, printing costs, and other items needed to support the programs that benefit the survivors of domestic violence and sexual assault in Placer County.
