SUBJECT: 2015 Drought and Water Situation Update Presentation

Action Requested

Receive an update of what Placer County Departments continue to perform to conserve water during this drought and what actions have been put in place for future water savings. PCWA Staff will present information to the Board on the current water availability, state mandates for conservation and PCWA conservation program progress.

Background

County staff along with each of the water agencies in Western Placer County have been working together to provide information, coordination and service to the residents during this drought year. Despite less than normal precipitation and the lack of snow pack, the drought effects have been reduced by the water conservation efforts locally and a change to the release of flows within Folsom Reservoir by federal and state operators. County departments, water agencies and citizens within our county continue to look at ways to conserve water and thanks to those past year efforts; there is enough water to meet the demands this year.
