Mary also championed key property acquisitions including the Bill Santucci Justice Center, Heritage Plaza in Tahoe City, and Hidden Falls Regional Park, and developed the long-term vision of preserving public access to County Beaches at Lake Tahoe.

In 2005, Mary was promoted to Assistant Director of Facility Services. In 2013, Mary was selected Director of Facility Services and Executive Director for the Western Placer Waste Management Authority. Mary led with great vision and purpose, developing an enduring legacy of service and commitment, with a sense of pride in a culture of collective ownership. Mary became known for her ability to orchestrate solutions and embrace controversial issues, and invested countless hours mentoring, training, and counseling her team.
