**Action Requested**

Approve the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) application in the amount of \$20,720 to partially fund one Deputy Sheriff assigned to the Placer County Special Investigations Unit, and authorize the Sheriff to sign required documentation.

**Background**

The Sheriff's Office plans to utilize the annual JAG Grant for FY 2015-16 to partially offset the costs for one Deputy Sheriff assigned to the Special Investigations Unit (SIU) task force. This position works as a liaison between SIU, the Courts and other County departments, and monitors high-risk situations for children in Placer County. To help ensure the safety and well-being of Placer County residents, SIU works with School Resource Officers to identify individuals who are selling drugs at local schools, and to help determine what drugs are being sold such as methamphetamines, marijuana, and other illegal narcotics.

**Fiscal Impact**

Funds in the amount of \$20,720 are included in the Sheriff's Office FY 2015-16 Proposed Budget. There is no additional impact to the General Fund.
