- There were no fires on July 4, 2014 in the Sheridan MAC area.
- There were no fire work complaints

- The County is looking into possibly purchasing the property next to the current fire station to be able to expand and update the current station.
- Cal Fire has added a second helicopter to their fleet from state resources. This will be staged out of Auburn.
- The Monticello fire burned approximately 4500 acres and was about 85% contained.
- There was a arson started fire in the Dry Creek community that burned five houses
- The Cal Expo fire started small and ended up turning into a larger fire.
- The County wants Placer County Fire / Cal Fire to see where they can cut cost. The department is good through the 2014-2015 fiscal year.

7. Information tem:

A) **Ada Barros gave an update on the Placer County Vector Control.**

- Vector is any animal capable of transmitting causative agent of human diseases or capable of producing discomfort.
- The mosquito life cycle is adulticide; larvacide, biological and source reduction.
- Placer County Vector control is fully staffed. There are field techs sampling standing water for larvae. The action threshold is 1 larvae in 5 dips. Draining water is a good preventative and treatment measure.

• Mosquito	108	89	2528

- Mosquitos in the news.

- Aedes albopictus (found in Southern California 2011)
- Aedes Aegypti (yellow fever) found in Central and Northern California 2013)
- Both species are capable of transmitting disease that are not currently in California. Dengue (human host) found in Central Asia and North and South Africa.
- Next steps for invasive procedure: Broad education campaign to raise awareness; redirecting resources towards invasive species surveillance. Tools obtained for additional surveillance and control. Eradication relies on extensive help and cooperation from the public.
- On July 10th and 11th Vector Control will be flying over Sheridan and West Roseville.
- On July 9, 2014 the County revealed its first positive West Nile in Sheridan.

B. Planning Commission Overview of the Sheridan Community Plan presented by Chris Schmidt.

On June 12, 2014 the Planning Commission heard the MAC's recommendations. There was opposition from a property owner of 33 acres regarding the rezoning from farm to industrial.
