D. Dowd Road Over Yankee Slough Bridge Replacement Project Contract No. 1200

The Department of Public Works (DPW) is working to replace the existing bridge on Dowd Road at Yankee Slough under the Federal Highway Bridge Program (HBP). Caltrans recommended immediate closure of this structure primarily due to the excessive sagging of the bridge. The County installed a temporary support at mid-span and later replaced it with an alternative support system to prevent further structural deterioration and collapse. The bridge and improved approach will bring this bridge into compliance with current structural, geometric, and hydraulic guidelines. DPW will provide an overview of the project and possible impacts to the community.
