**A. Overview of the Middle Fork project and its significance to Placer County Water**

The Middle Fork Project (MFP) is a multi-purpose water supply and hydro-generation project designed to conserve and control waters of the Middle Fork American River, the Rubicon River, and several associated tributary streams. The purpose is to meet municipal, industrial, and agricultural demands within western Placer County, to provide recreational experiences, to contribute to the natural resource preservation and enhancement of the river and to generate power for the California electrical grid. In 2006, the Placer County Water Agency (PCWA) and the County of Placer entered in to a Joint Powers approve Future Electrical Energy Sales, fund the necessary operational costs and to distribute revenues from Future Electrical Energy Sales to both PCWA and Placer County.

**B. Drought update from the Placer County Office of Emergency Services (OES)**

The MAC will receive an update on the current drought conditions and actions being taken. At the beginning of 2014, with low reservoir levels and a meager Sierra snowpack, the county began working with Western Placer County water agencies on how to deal with the drought. Not being a water purveyor or holder of water rights, the County formed a drought task force and serves as a coordinator with affected

entities and the public. Agencies participating in the Drought Task Force include PC Agriculture Commission, Cal Fire/Placer County Fire, PC Environmental Health, PC Fire Safe Alliance, PC Resource Conservation District, PC Department of Public Works, select water providers and other city representation. **Presenter John McEldowney, Program Director, Office of Emergency Services, will present this update on the Drought Task Force efforts.**
