B. North Auburn Offender Supervision Services

- 1. Placer County Adult Supervision Services:** The Placer County Probation Department currently supervises approximately 3700 adult offenders granted formal probation, Post Release Community Supervision and those placed on Mandatory Supervision pursuant to Parole Realignment (AB 109). The department utilizes a balanced approach by enforcing laws, conditions of release and directing offenders to appropriate risk based rehabilitative services. The purpose of this presentation is to give MAC members and the public an update on our offender supervision practices and our approach to supervising homeless offenders in the community.
